The Cuban Society for the Promotion of Energy Renewable Sources and Environmental Awareness (Cubasolar) hereby calls for the 14th edition of the International Workshop Cubasolar 2020, to be held at the Hotel Playa Paraiso, located on the fourth largest island of the Cuban archipelago, Cayo Coco, in Ciego de Avila province.

The aim of the workshop is to continue fostering the conscious creation of a sustainable energy system based on renewable energy sources and environmental awareness. Furthermore, it will encourage and promote the dialogue and exchange of experiences and practices among specialists and people interested in issues related to energy, water and food, as well as in cooperation and knowledge and technologies transfer.

The Workshop includes lectures and workshops, involving government authorities, researchers, educators, specialists, managers, entrepreneurs, professionals, producers, users of technologies and other people who work for the sustainability of our planet.

Main topics of the workshop

- Food sovereignty and renewable energy sources.
- Water supply and renewable energy sources.
- Tourism and renewable energy sources.
- Energy sovereignty, environment and sustainable local development.
- Energy education, culture and information for sustainability.

Workshop course

Essential content of the event will be the development of workshops on the topics of water, energy and food, associated with the use of renewable energy sources, and energy and environmental education and communication. The course is offered at no additional cost. It is accredited by University of the host province. Different activities have been organized as part of the event such as master lectures, three workshops and field visits, thus favoring the wide participation and exchange on topics and knowledge of the Cuban experience in the present context of social and economic development in the country.

Guidelines for papers submission

The participants interested in submitting poster-format papers shall send an abstract by e-mail to the Organizing Committee. The abstract shall be in Spanish. It should be no more than 500 words, formatted in Microsoft Word, 1.5 spaced using size 12 Arial font. It shall include: Title, authors, country, institution, email, objectives, proposals or alternatives and achieved or expected results. The deadline for the presentation of papers is **December 15**th, **2019**. The selected papers shall be notified before **February 15**th, **2020**.

The presentations on posters will be made in an area designated for that purpose. The posters size shall not exceed 0.7m wide x 1.0m long and must be delivered to the Organizing Committee in the accreditation office of the event venue.

Publication of the extensive works

The Organizing Committee shall publish the extensive work of the authors that wish it in the CD of the event. Those interested should send the work by **March 15th, 2020** and the guidelines are: Presentation in Microsoft Word version, size 12 Arial font, 1,5 spacing between lines, 2000-5000 words (approximately, not counting the annexes). It shall include: Title, Data of the author (s), Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Development (which may include Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion), Conclusions, Recommendations, References or bibliography, and Annexes (if there is any).

If the authors are interested, the work may be evaluated for its publication in the digital scientific journal $Eco\ Solar$ (categorized in Latindex), and in the printed magazine $Energia\ y\ T\acute{u}$, which has popular scientific nature.

Registration and payment fees

The registration fee for the event is **260 CUC**.

The registration fee entitles you to participate in all official activities, material module for meetings, to use the arranged local means of transportation to the different places specified in the program, as well as to get certificates of attendance and copyright if papers were submitted. Travel and lodging expenses are not included. These aspects, in the case of foreign delegates, should be dealt directly with the agencies promoting the event.
